Summary

On 6 May 2002, the European Commission (EC) and the government of the Netherlands hosted an international seminar on "Mobile and Wireless Systems and Networks beyond 3G in the European Framework Programme for R&D". The focus of this meeting was on the broad area of information services, including computing and human-system interfaces, not simply on mobile networking.

This seminar was a forum for industry and academia to precede the issuing of a formal request for proposals by the EC and was intended to provide initial definition of the concept for EC funding of research in areas involving wireless networking and computing services. The EC approach appears to be similar to a Broad Agency Announcement, and this meeting was evidently intended to help coordinate the development of the formal EC announcement and call for proposals.
